Less to Landfill Challenge

Registrations are now open for the Wipe Out Waste Less to Landfill Challenge.

The challenge runs over six weeks with the aim to reduce the material that a class sends to landfill each day to just one mini wheelie bin (300mL) or less!

You can take the challenge with as few or as many classes as you like.

Each class will need to think outside the square to come up with alternative solutions (reducing, reusing or recycling) for the materials that are usually being sent to landfill each day.

KESAB environmental solutions in partnership with Recyclers SA is creating the 2014 Enviro Calendar.

We are calling on schools, community groups/ organisations and councils to enter the Competition.

The theme is innovative waste receptacles, bin art and creative signage, with Litter and Recycling as the focus.

What makes your bins stand out? The easier a bin is to see, the more likely people are to use it properly. If you have clear signage about what goes in the bin then you can avoid contamination and encourage recycling.

Conditions for entry:

- Art must be original and creative
- Entry is by photograph of your bin art, waste receptacle or signage. Please take up to 3 clear photographs (suitable for reprint). Photographs must be high resolution.
- No copyright, syndicated or clip art is to be used.
- Photos need to be labelled with the school/ organisation/council name.
- Up to 5 different entries can be made per organisation.
- An entry form is required to enter, and can be found on the KESAB website - www.kesab.asn.au from July 2013
- **Cash prizes will be awarded to winning schools** and community groups, and councils will be awarded with a free walk through audit (details on website)

All entries/ photographs become the property of KESAB environmental solutions and KESAB reserves the right to modify any artwork for reproduction purposes.

Entries will be used to create the KESAB 2014 Enviro Calendar, and each school, council and community group will receive one free calendar later in 2013. Calendars will also be for sale.
