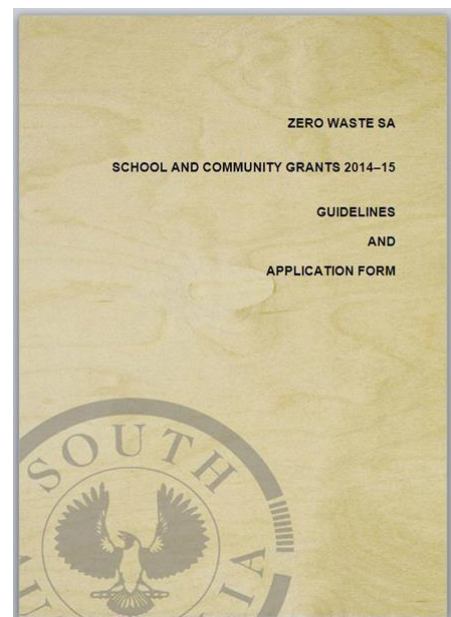
Grants must be spent by December 2014, and reported on in Dec 2014/Jan 2015, so only consider applying for projects that can be completed and reported on in this time frame.

Classes develop their own reducing, reusing or recycling solutions for the materials that are currently sent to landfill each day.
