WOW in Term 2, 2014

Term 1, 2014 was been one of the biggest terms ever for WOW, and Term 2 is huge as well!

Additional funding from Zero Waste SA to focus on early years- preschool/childcare sector has provided great results, with over 90 childcare and preschool sites attending PD sessions so far this year.



ZWSA school and community grants

Applications closed for the Zero Waste SA School and Community Grants on April 7th. This is the first year child care centres have been eligible to apply and over 100 applications were received. Grants were for infrastructure items including recycling and compost bins, chicken coops and worm farms, etc. Eligible projects demonstrated the diversion of materials that would otherwise be sent to landfill. The review process has taken place and applicants will be advised regarding their applications by the end of June.

WOW \$200 grants

When staff from your site attend a WOW PD session, you can receive a \$200 grant when we receive your: PD session Evaluation, Solid Waste Census and Grant Application form.

If you have been to a PD session in the last year- we must receive your information for processing by **May 14th**, so that we can process it before the end of the financial year. Please get in touch if you are missing any of the required forms- **soon!**

NRM action grants

The Adelaide and Mount Lofty Ranges Natural Resources Management Board provides small grant funding of up to \$1 500 for projects that promote the sustainable management of our natural resources.

This grant is supported through the board's NRM Education program which supports schools to explore environmental sustainability in their learning programs and management practices. Grants opened May 5th and close June 27th.

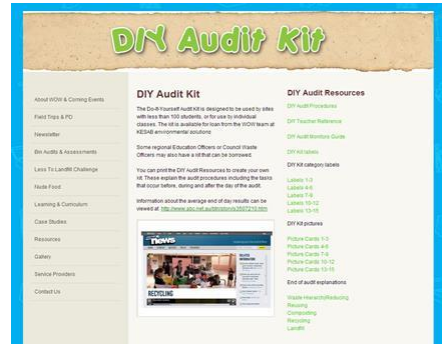
