Soft plastic recycling with REDcycle

While it's good to Recycle, REDUCING is always the preferred option. As the ABC's War on Waste highlighted, recycling still has challenges, and we need to remember that recycling requires buying recycled products to close the loop!

If you are currently collecting soft plastics at your site, or intend to start, we recommend only collecting plastic that is free from any food remnants (to avoid safety issues). Click [here](#) for this image.
