


The Journey Of My Bins



Waste/Landfill

Red or Blue Lid

(the colour depends on where you live!)



The **landfill** bin is for things that we are not able to **recycle**, **compost** or **reuse**.

Yellow Lid



The **recycling** bin is for things that can be made into new things.

Green Organics

Green Lid



The **green organics** bin is for things that can be turned into **compost**.

Waste/Landfill

When the bin is placed on the kerb, a truck comes and empties the bin.



Recycling

When the bin is placed on the kerb, a truck comes and empties the bin.



Green Organics

When the bin is placed on the kerb, a truck comes and empties the bin.



Waste/Landfill

The truck goes to a Waste Transfer Station and tips out the **waste**.



Recycling

The truck goes to a Material Recovery Facility and tips out the **recycling**.



Green Organics

The truck goes to a Transfer Station and tips out the **green organics**.



Waste/Landfill

The waste is crushed and loaded into a truck.



Recycling

The materials are sorted into different types by machine and by hand.



Green Organics

The green organics are piled into windrows to decompose.



Waste/Landfill

The waste is taken to a landfill and buried.



Recycling

The sorted materials are baled and sent to be made into new things.



Green Organics

Things that don't belong in the **green organics** are removed by machine and by hand.



Waste/Landfill

Materials in landfill are buried and will not be used again.



Recycling

Materials from the recycling bin are made into new things.



Green Organics

Organic materials decompose into compost, which helps plants grow.
