I am worth 10c and can also be recycled at a depot.

After you put us out for recycling, we head off on our recycling journey.

A recycling truck takes us to this place called a **Materials Recovery Facility** (MRF) and drops us here with lots of other recyclables.

I'm worth 10c so collect me at school to make money! Remember to empty me and take out my straw.

If I'm not recycled, it can take more than 30 years for me to break down in landfill.

Hey! It's GREAT in here!

Let's find out what happens to us at the MAR





At the MRF we are scooped up with other recyclables and put on conveyor belts for sorting.

During the sorting process, we have a ride in a big cylinder called a 'trommel' which helps separate different recyclable materials.

Some MRFs also use a 'bounce conveyor' to make sure we are separated.

Cartons with a 10c deposit are sorted by hand - they are VERY valuable!
